### A NEW ROOF FOR THE COPE HOUSE



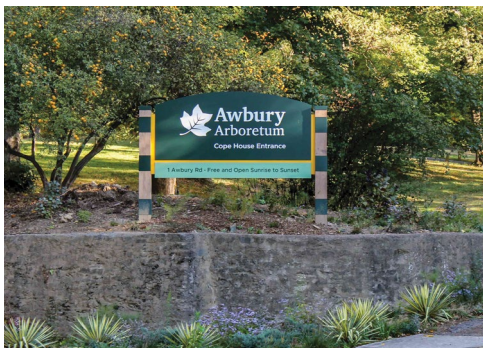

### A NEW PAVILION



AdventureWoods, our historic secret garden, now has a brand new open air shelter where it once had none. The pavilion will serve hundreds of campers and makes this special area of the Arboretum much more accommodating for a variety of uses year-round.
